



Miguel “EL MAMBO” DeLeon

Miguel “MAMBO” DeLeon has been in the works since the early 1980’s. With the lack of Latin Jazz and Salsa



music in the Midwest during the 1980’s, Miguel became known as the “Midwest Mambo King”. He introduced Salsa and True Latin Jazz to the Midwestern states, and re-introduced them to the historic 18th & Vine in Kansas City, Missouri.

Miguel is a first generation Puerto Rican-American originally from Lorain, Ohio (20 miles west of Cleveland). He began his calling in the Latin music movement in the early 1970's and continues to this day. Some of the Latin Legends that Miguel has worked with over the years:

While in the Midwest, Miguel opened numerous times for the legendary Tito Puente (Sr.), Poncho Sanchez, Grupo Niche, Grupo Gale and Santana. 2009 reunited Miguel with Latin legend Larry Harlow at the Voo Doo Lounge at Harrahs Casino in Kansas City, Missouri.

Miguel performed and toured with Salsa legend Roberto Roena in Puerto Rico, including opening for Sting.

Miguel’s credits and collaborations include:

- Lead and background vocals with Roberto Roena y su Apollo Sound in the 1995 release of Roberto Roenas 25th Anniversary “Vivo en Bellas Artes” from Puerto Rico singing the Salsa version of Sting’s hit, “Every Breath You Take”.
- The 2004 release of “Con Salsa Y Sabor” singing lead vocals with brother Sammy DeLeon Orquesta
- 2010 CD Release of “Pasiones del Alma” (Passions of the Soul)
- 2012 single release of “Pa’l Bailador Mundial” (For the World Dancer)
- 2012 single release of “Ojos de Pasion” (Eyes of Passion)
- 2013 single release of “La Guerra Salsera” (Salsa War)
